Mr. Lance Thatcher was in attendance at the Committee of the Whole Meeting. Mr. Thatcher asked for and received confirmation that the City would rectify bylaw infractions after October 31, 2004 if he had not complied.

Council upheld resolution number 0389/04 from the October 12, 2004 Regular Council Meeting which states:

"THAT as Mr. Thatcher has chosen not to appear before Council pursuant to Section 77 of the *Community Charter*, and if Mr. Thatcher has not complied with the requests to rectify bylaw infractions by October 31, 2004, staff are instructed to clean up the unsightly premises, remove unlicensed and derelict vehicles and remove the illegal structure on the property with all costs for these actions attributed to Mr. Thatcher; AND THAT any amounts unpaid at year end be added to Mr. Thatcher's property taxes as outstanding amounts due."
