BYLAW NO. 2044

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS BY MEANS OF A TICKETING SYSTEM (MTI)

(CONSOLIDATED FOR CONVENIENCE ONLY, INCLUDING BASE BYLAW NO. 2044(2009) AND AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2189 (2015), 2195 (2015), 2199 (2015), 2201 (2015) and 2213 (2016))

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* authorizes Council, by bylaw, to:

- (1) Designate those bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of ticket prescribed by regulation;
- (2) Designate Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing bylaws by means of a prescribed form of ticket;
- (3) Designate an offence against a bylaw by means of a word or expression on a ticket; and,
- (4) Set fines not greater than the amount prescribed by regulation;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Merritt in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Merritt has adopted Bylaw No. 2044, being a bylaw to PROVIDE FOR BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS BY MEANS OF A TICKETING SYSTEM;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirous to amend Bylaw No. 2044 to update Schedule A to include provisions for municipal ticketing for violations pertaining to irresponsible waste container management and reducing impacts on wildlife inter alia; Amending Bylaw No. 2189, 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Merritt has adopted Bylaw No. 2044, being a bylaw to PROVIDE FOR BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS BY MEANS OF A TICKETING SYSTEM;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirous to amend Bylaw No. 2044 to update Schedule A and the Appendices to reference certain replacement Bylaws and for them to be enforced via Municipal Ticket Information Amending Bylaw No. 2195, 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Merritt has adopted Bylaw No. 2044, being a bylaw to PROVIDE FOR BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS BY MEANS OF A TICKETING SYSTEM;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirous to amend Bylaw No. 2044 to update Schedule A to include provisions for municipal ticketing for violations pertaining to the irresponsible use of fuel burning appliances Amending Bylaw No. 2201, 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Merritt has adopted Bylaw No. 2044, being a bylaw to PROVIDE FOR BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS BY MEANS OF A TICKETING SYSTEM;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the City of Merritt deems it desirous to amend Bylaw No. 2044 to update Schedule A to include smoking regulations in accordance with City of Merritt Parks Regulation Amending Bylaw No. 2211, 2016 Amending Bylaw No. 2213, 2016

CITATION

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw 2044, 2009"

REPEAL

2. "Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 1912, 2005" and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

ENFORCEMENT

- 3. The bylaws, which shall include any amendment thereto, as listed in Column 1 of Schedule A to this Bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed.
- 4. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule A to this Bylaw are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A opposite the respective job positions.
- 5. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of the Appendices to Schedule A of this bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.
- 6. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of the Appendices to Schedule A of this Bylaw are the fines set pursuant to the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
